### DIRECTOR'S NOTE

The story of *Spring Awakening* may appear as the simple coming of age experiences of restless youth in 1890s Germany, but at closer inspection the timelessness, universality, and relevance of the issues raised then hit us hard in 2023 America.

Like *Hamilton*, with an artistic casting choice to tell the story of America's past with America's present, the vision of EWP's *Spring Awakening* is to tell the story of the youth of 1890s Germany with the youth of 2023 America.

The population of our American youth will soon be majority POC (persons of color). All of our young Gen Z performers are POC, most being of mixed heritage or mixed-race. This is their story. This is our story we present to you. The battle as the balance of power shifts to a different majority makes our production of *Spring Awakening* unique from other productions. There will be casualties, but in the end—like the seasons—the Spring will turn to Summer.

EWP's production of *Spring Awakening* is saying, no, demanding that youth voices be amplified and that the marginalized POC youth voices be recognized as a major force to be reckoned with in years to come. We all need to support, love, and nurture our youth in ways that are unique to each individual.

He is producing artistic director emeritus of East West Players (EWP), having run the longest running professional theatre of color in the United States for 23 years through 2016 producing over a hundred plays and musicals.

For six years, Tim was adjunct lecturer teaching directing and dramaturgy at the USC School of Dramatic Arts and prepared emerging artists about the audition process, industry business essentials, and networking at AMDA College for the Performing Arts.

For four years, he served as an LA County Arts Commissioner appointed by Supervisor Hilda Solis for District 1through 2022. He was co-chair of the Cultural Equity and Inclusion Initiative Advisory Committee through the LA County Board of Supervisors advocating cultural policy and arts initiatives that create healthy and vibrant communities for every Angeleno on every square mile of the largest County in the United States. He was also appointed as the Arts and Culture Sector Leader for the County's Economic Resiliency Task Force providing strategies and recommendations to the Board of Supervisors in response to the Covid-19 pandemic and the civil unrest due to racial and social inequities across our country.

Tim's directorial credits include King of the Yees and The Joy Luck Club at Sierra Madre Playhouse, A Chorus Line and Evita at USC, Songs for a New World, Edges, and Ordinary Days at AMDA, Vietgone and Sisters Matsumoto at L.A. Theatre Works, Pippin for Pomona College, The Emperor's Nightingale for Mainstreet Theatre in San Bernardino County.

He is an alumnus of the University of Southern California School of Theatre.
